Community Leaders Institute (Friday, December 5)

A 6-week leadership development training program designed to enhance research and capacity building competencies for community organizations, practices and health advocates. \$1,000-\$1,500 provided to complete a community research project. [Read more](#)

Community Health Program Grant (deadline extended one week to Friday, December 19)

Supports health partnerships between academic and community organizations/programs or physician practices that improve outcomes in children, adults, and/or community. Up to \$20,000 per project. [Read more](#)

Methodologic Research Program (Monday, January 26)

Designed to advance methodologic research in biostatistics, epidemiology, bioinformatics and related disciplines in order to enhance the capacity to conduct and analyze data from clinical and translational studies. Up to \$10,000 may be requested for a one year award. [Read more](#)

Research in Residency Program Update

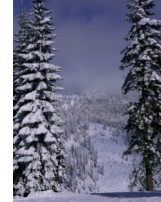
