Community Health Program Grant (optional LOI due Nov 14, proposal due Dec 12)

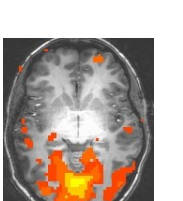
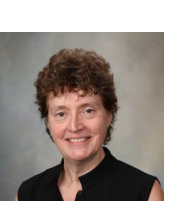
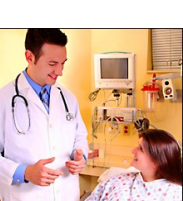
