T1 translational research seeks to apply clinical or basic research knowledge in an identifiable pathway towards the development of trials and studies in humans. Program funds new or competing renewal pilot proposals (up to \$100K); new research infrastructure through innovative core facilities (up to \$50K/year for 1-2 years); and pilot projects of junior investigators (up to \$25K).
