

CCRF ENDOWED SCHOLARS PROGRAM

Call for Applications

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Monday, August 1, 2016 @ 5 P.M.

GOALS

To recognize and accelerate the success of assistant and associate professors who are emerging leaders as demonstrated by their scientific contributions and their impact. We are targeting our still rising stars to provide additional support that will allow creative extension of existing work, or taking on new projects, to enhance ongoing extramural funding and overall productivity.

ELIGIBILITY

This program is designed for assistant or associate professors employed by CCHMC. All individuals competitive for this recognition are encouraged to apply. The successful candidates will have NIH R01 or equivalent extramural funding. Outstanding publications and future research vision are key review criteria.

AWARD CHARACTERISTICS

Each successful candidate will receive a \$1.75M Endowed Scholar designation, which is anticipated to yield approximately \$50,000 in flexible research support per year during the support period. These funds can be used as chosen by the awardee to optimally accelerate the individual's research success and acquisition of a second R01 equivalent. In general, 2 awards will be made annually with the duration of three years each with demonstration of appropriate progress.

APPLICATION

The application is limited to a CV plus a two-page statement including 1) the candidate's highest impact achievements, 2) career goals, 3) how this award will help achieve these goals, 4) how the monies will be used, and 5) a list of three potential evaluators, outside of CCHMC, who can comment on the impact of their work. These individuals will be contacted only for award finalists. The application must be submitted by email as ONE PDF attachment.

ACTIVATION

In the inaugural year, two scholars will be chosen by October 1, 2016, and the award will be activated on January 1, 2017. Applications are due August 1, 2016. In subsequent years the Scholar(s) will be chosen in February and the award(s) will start in July. The next call for applications will be for the due date of October 15, 2016.
